

## Riverwood National Thursday Evening Men's Golf Club League 2010

This letter is designed to answer some of the questions you might have about the league by outlining certain areas.

### Joining League

The Men's League fee will be \$80.00. The fee pays your USGA handicap, and the remaining money is divided between the weekly events, and the Men's League Championship.

### Weekly Registration

An event sign-up tee-sheet will be posted one week prior to the weekly event. You may sign up as a group selecting an open tee-time between 4 and 6pm, or you can sign up as a single or 2-some and we help to pair you with others. Registration will begin each Thursday night 30 minutes prior to the first tee-time of that event, during shotguns registration will open 1 hour prior to the start of the shotgun. Please pay your greens fees in the Pro Shop prior to registering for the event. **At registration you will pay a weekly \$5.00 "Net Skins" entry fee. The weekly "Net Skins" entry fee automatically includes you each week. Each week you can also pay an additional \$5.00 "Gross Skins" entry to be included each week. The \$5.00 "Gross Skins" entry fee is optional every week.** You will also be given the rules sheet and skill prize information for that night's event.

### Prizes

Each night prizes will be awarded in the form of credit that may be used to purchase merchandise in the Pro Shops. We will keep track of the credits earned and each week we will post a sheet with the event winners and winnings along with your account balances. When you would like to use your credit for a purchase in the Pro Shop you may bring your purchase to the counter and the staff will assist you. You may not have a negative balance on your credit account, so you will have to wait until you earn more money or simply pay the balance at the time of purchase. All credit **must** be used by October 1<sup>st</sup> 2010.

### Score Posting

Each player in the group is responsible for ensuring their score is accurate, the Scorer signs the card and someone signs the scorecard & attests the scores on the card. Each week **you are responsible for entering your weekly score into the system.** All scorecards are to be placed in the Men's Club Scorecard Box located in the Pro Shop. **The Men's Golf Club officers will be responsible for checking all scores for all Men's Golf Club weekly events to ensure accuracy.** You are also responsible for entering all your scores for any other rounds you play outside the Men's Golf Club League events.

### Results

**The weekly event results and the weekly skill prizes (Closest to Pin(s) & Long Putt(s)) will be posted on the Men's Golf Club League board in the clubhouse on Thursday night!**

### Individual Points Race

**The Individual Points Race will be replaced with a "Tournament of Champions" tournament with additional payouts at year end.** More information to come on this new and exciting change to the 2010 Men's Golf Club league!

### Tournaments

The Men's Golf Club will be sponsoring several tournaments in 2010. These tournaments are open to Men's Golf Club members and non-members. All tournament participants **MUST** have a GHIN handicap in order to participate. All tournaments will have an entry fee to participate. ### **Establishing a Handicap**

To establish a handicap you will need to post 5 - 18 Hole scores. If you have some scorecards from a trip out of state this past winter you may use those scores to establish a handicap. The first 5 weeks of Men's League we will assign handicaps to those of you without an established handicap. This handicap will be based on the best score of your last 5 - 18 hole scores. **As of week 6, if you haven't established a handicap you will be ineligible for prizes. So, please get out there and play some golf to get your handicap established.** You may combine 9 hole rounds to establish a handicap.
